Information Request

Attn: Robbery Units along Interstate 95 from New York to Virginia

This agency is investigating a capital murder case from 1988 in which the suspect is believed to have committed an armed robbery shortly after the incident.

On December 4, 1988, two subjects were fatally shot in Fairfax County, Virginia. The suspect fled to New York in one of the victim's vehicle, later recovered in Jamaica, Queens, New York. He is believed to have been driven back to Virginia between December 4 and 6, 1988. His companion has stated the suspect robbed a convenience store with a handgun, "just off the highway".

We are attempting to identify the location of this robbery and ask your agency to research their databases between December 4 and 6, 1988, for any unsolved robbery that may be attributed to the suspect. The exact route taken is not known, but is believed to be the most direct route one might take, to include Interstate 95 (or associated Beltways), the New Jersey Turnpike, and the Delaware Turnpike.

The suspect is a Hispanic male, traveling with a teenage Hispanic female, in an unknown type vehicle.
